NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS AND PLAN HOLDERS

The Solicitation is amended by the following clarifications/changes/additional information. If any provision in this Addendum conflicts with any existing provisions in the Solicitation, this Addendum will control. All other terms, conditions, and provisions of the Solicitation remain in effect as published.

By signing and submitting a Bid or Proposal, the Bidder/Proposer is acknowledging that they will abide by all Addenda issued prior to the opening of the Bids/Proposals and agrees that all pricing is inclusive of all Addenda content, information, changes and clarifications.

PROPOSAL SUBMITTAL DEADLINE

The submittal due date and time <u>remains</u> 2:00 PM, LOCAL TIME, JUNE 6, 2023 and is NOT CHANGED BY THIS ADDENDUM.

The Contents of this Addendum alter and amend the original drawings and specifications and take precedence over the related items therein. All other provisions of the Specifications, Drawings, and Contract Documents shall remain unchanged and in full effect.

This Addendum shall be attached to the affected portions of the Construction Documents.

This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and modifies the original bidding documents dated October 2022 as noted below. Bidders are instructed to indicate each Addendum received in the appropriate location on the Form of Proposal as acknowledgement of receipt of all issued Addenda to the Contract Documents. Failure to do so may result in the rejection of your proposal (bid).

I. <u>BIDDER QUESTIONS</u>

The following contains Bidder Questions received to date with answers provided herein. The Questions were submitted within the Questions Due Date period of this solicitation.

- Q1 The phase notes state that traffic control flaggers must be present 24 hours a day during road closures regardless of if construction is taking place at that point it time. In light of this will the owner allow the use of robotic flagging stations, or must the flagging operations be conducted manually with onsite personnel?
- A1 Please see revised Plan Sheets G-081 to G-085. The requirements for 24 hour a day traffic control is no longer required.

- Q2 Will 24 hour work be allowed for phase 2 to possibly allow for a faster completion especially since 24 hour work is mandated for the southbound side of the street during phase 1 construction operations?
- A2 Contractor work hours have been revised to be from 8:00pm to 6:00 am for all phases and work shifts.
- Q3 Will flaggers be required at each of the private driveway entrances/exits throughout the project when they are obstructed by construction operations as they are not currently shown in these locations on the plans?
- A3 Flaggers are not required at each private driveway. Please see revised Plan Sheets G-081 to G-085 for required temporary construction signage.
- Q4 The plans state that work will be allowed 24 hours per day in phase 1 but the special provisions in the specs state night work only. Which one is correct?
- A4 Please see the answer to question #2 above.
- Q5 Section 107.2 of the specifications states that the contractor is responsible for the cost of all permits not provided by the owner. In light of this what permits will the contractor be responsible for procuring and what permits will be provided by the owner and what permits will the owner waive the fees for?
- A5 Bidders should refer to Paragraphs 10 and 32 of the Construction Special Terms and Conditions of the Solicitation for questions regarding permits. These sections take precedence over the section referenced for this question.

Phase 3	4 Working Days (Night Work Only from 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM)
Phase 4	4 Working Days (Night Work Only from 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM)
